The consultant will work with members of the SCCSS Board of Directors, community volunteers and staff to deliver a multi-faceted capital campaign and fundraising strategy. The candidate should possess recent experience in capital campaign planning or have a similar background and be familiar with the community of the Sunshine Coast and the fundraising environment.

- Build on the development of existing collateral materials, including a case for support, marketing materials, partnerships, and promotions that are required for general fundraising strategy.
- Lead Capital Campaign Committee.
- Help identify capital grants and provide information to the grant writer to complete capital grants.

- Continue to develop a plan/strategy for ongoing donor stewardship and donor cultivation.

- Your vision and objectives for the project, as well as your understanding of the work to be undertaken;
- Your approach to the project;
- The proposed schedule of milestones, activities and duration;
- Your personal experience with similar projects; and
- Expected compensation
