We are offering several grants up to and including \$500. Applicants may request funding assistance for opportunities such as music lessons, musical instruments, electronic production, studio time or studio mentoring.

This Endowment Fund is held by Sunshine Coast Foundation and is the result of the collaboration of the Coast Cultural Alliance, Sunshine Coast Community Services Society, the late Daniel Kingsbury and the members of the 'Waking Life' 2005 student music project.

Criteria for selection

Youth aged 13 to 19 residing on the Sunshine Coast Youth requiring financial assistance to further musical goals Youth with experience or interest in any of the following:

- · Creating original music
- · Performing music
- · Recording music

Youth with an interest in contributing back to the community

Selection Committee

There will be a Selection Committee with representatives from:

- Sunshine Coast Community Services Society (SCCSS), provider of youth support programs
- Coast Cultural Alliance (CCA), contributing organization promoting arts and culture
- Representatives of Daniel Kingsbury's family

The Selection Committee will award the grants to the applicants who best meet the criteria.

The Selection Committee will hold applications in confidence. The names of the grant recipients will also be held in confidence unless they consent to public acknowledgement.

Grant funds will be disbursed directly to the service provider (music teacher, studio, retail outlet, other) and must be used by <u>August 31, 2021.</u>
