

# Job Description Thrift Store Assistant Community Action and Engagement

### **Summary:**

The Thrift store assistant supports the day-to-day operations of the SCCSS Thrift Store and creates a welcoming retail environment for customers, donors, clients, and volunteers. The Thrift store assistant reports to the Volunteer Program Lead.

#### **Key Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Operating the till, receiving and processing cash and charge/credit payments
- Provide exceptional customer service during our business hours; help customers locate items in the store
- Support and implement creative merchandising and inventory rotation
- Assisting in the cash-in and cash-out procedures
- Supporting and engaging volunteers in a meaningful way
- Assist with receiving, organizing, sorting donations
- Assist with online sales administration and general store operations
- Resourcing and allocating recyclable materials, and other store duties
- Assists with other duties as required, from time to time, aiding with the efficient operation of the organization
- Demonstrates exceptional service while assisting customers and donors
